UNIFORM POLICY

Rationale

At East Marden Primary School

- School uniforms eliminate peer pressure and reduces competition between students on the basis of clothing.
- The wearing of a school uniform promotes a sense of belonging for students and creates a positive identity for the school community.
- School uniforms also contribute to the personal safety of students by allowing easier recognition of students inside the school community.
- The school uniform takes into account the diverse nature of our school population. All students should have the opportunity to access the full range of school activities, including physical activities, whilst wearing a school uniform.

Responsibilities

Governing Council

- Through consultation with the community, develop and review the dress code for the students.

School

- Collectively lead the development and review of school uniform requirements.
- Oversee contract negotiations with school uniform supplies.
- Inform parents and carers of uniform requirements via assemblies, class meetings, SRC and newsletter.
- Provide assistance to families in need.

Parents

- Provide their child/ren with a school uniform that meets the policy and raise any concerns with the Principal
- Label all students clothing
- Notify class teacher of occasional necessary non compliance
- Encourage students to wear the uniform.

Students

- Wear a school uniform that meets the schools uniform requirements.

Uniform

- Royal short sleeved or long sleeved polo top with logo
- Jacket with logo
- Navy bucket hat with logo
- School print dress
- Royal striped rugby windcheater with logo
- Navy culottes/skort



UNIFORM POLICY

Uniform cont..

- Winter tunic/skirt
- Navy shorts
- Navy pants
- Leggings under garments – Leggings are NOT to be worn as pants
- Long sleeved white or navy skivvy/top under school polo, winter tunic
- Sneakers, Shoes or Sandals
- Other cultural headwear

Year 6 uniform (from 2021)

All of the above plus -
Optional specially designed Year 6 polo top and Year 6 jumper.
SAPSASA Jumper in the year of selection (except on a school excursion day)



School Bag

School logo back pack is required by all students (to be phased in from Reception class starting 2021)

Accessories Permitted

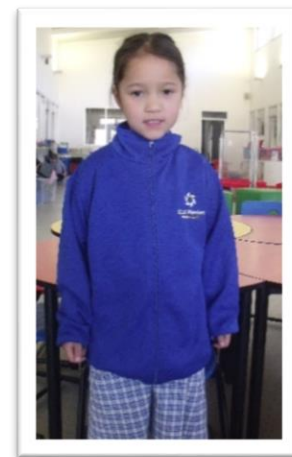
- Hair accessories in royal and navy blue, for safety and health reasons it is recommended that children with shoulder length or longer hair should have it tied back.
