


VACATION CARE PROGRAM



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BOOKINGS

- The cut off date for bookings is the **3rd of December**.
- **Accounts** are required to be **paid up-to-date** prior to securing bookings for vacation care.
- A **\$15.00 deposit** is required for each day of care booked when submitting the booking form.

*Families from external schools are required to pay fees in full prior to attending care.

CANCELLATIONS & ABSENCES

- Cancellation requests can be made with a minimum of **24 hours** notice.
- **Excursion days** may incur a **full fee charge** if position can not be filled by children on the waiting list.
- **Absences** without notifying the service will also incur a full fee.

COST & PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **\$50 full fee** for each day of care (incursions & excursions)
- Invoices are issued weekly and fees are due **within 7 days**

PARENT INFORMATION

CLOTHING

- Children must wear sun smart clothing, and **bring a bucket hat** when in attendance during Terms 1, 3 and 4.
- Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times during care.

BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

- 4 Step Choices are implemented to provide children opportunities to learn from unsafe or inappropriate choices. Children who persistently engage in uncooperative behaviour and/or threatens the safety and well-being of others may be suspended from care.

FOOD

- Breakfast and Afternoon Tea is provided everyday
- All foods served are nut free, vegetarian, and supports the Australian Dietary Guidelines.

MEDICATION

- Medical plans must be prescribed and authorised by a health professional in order for OSHC staff to administer medication.
- All medication must be clearly labelled with the child 's name.




