Parent Responsibilities Checklist

- Create claim for Child Care Subsidy (CCS) on MyGov – Centrelink
- Complete and submit OSHC Enrolment form along with Medical Plans and/or Risk Minimisation Plan (for children with additional health or special needs)
- Make bookings and cancellations in advance to avoid absence charges
- Inform the service of any changes regarding personal details and emergency contacts
- Provide children with appropriate clothing and resources for programmed activities: sun smart clothing, bucket hat, recess, drink bottle, lunch
- Clearly label children's belongings and collect items from lost property
- Arrange weekly payments via QKR! app

Enrolment & Bond Payment

Bookings & Cancellation requests must be submitted with a minimum of 24 hours' notice prior to the session of care commencing. Absences may incur full fee charges dependent on Child Care Subsidy eligibility.

Illness & Infection Control

For the safety and wellbeing of children, parents, staff and the school community, individuals with temperature of 37.5C or above will not be allowed access into the OSHC care environment. Any individual that is unwell should rest at home and return to care when they have recovered from flulike symptoms such as coughing, sore throat, fatigue and shortness of breath. Individuals should seek medical attention for symptoms of COVID-19. Parents / guardians will be contacted as soon as possible when children become unwell during the day for immediate collection.

Sun Safe Practice

Sun protection is implemented when UV rating is 3 or higher. Sun lotion will be provided and bucket hats must be worn by all children when engaging in outdoor environments. Educators will direct children to remain in shaded play spaces as much as possible to minimise risk of excessive sun exposure. Children without hats will be required to stay indoors or play in areas fully protected from sun exposure.

Medication and Injury Management

Medication and medical plans must be supplied by families to OSHC before commencing care. A *Risk Minimisation Plan* will help educators further support the health and wellbeing of children's needs. In the case of major injury or incident, every effort will be made to contact parents and emergency contacts as soon as possible.

Invoices & Payment Options

Invoices are issued weekly via email at the beginning of each week. Invoices can also be viewed online using our parent childcare app at http://eastmarden.spike.economicoutlook.net/clients/ Sign in using your email address and pin code.

Child Care Subsidy (CCS)

To Claim Child Care Subsidy, simply provide OSHC the CRN (Centrelink Reference Number) of the registered parent and the child when completing the enrolment form. Confirm care attended from MyGov notification after commencing care to finalise the claim.
