# **Terms and Conditions**

# **Bookings**

- The cut off date for bookings is the 5th of April.
- Accounts are required to be paid up-to-date prior to securing bookings for vacation care.
- A \$15.00 deposit is required for each day of care booked when submitting the booking form.
  - \*Families from external schools are required to pay fees in full prior to attending care.

### **Cancellations & Absences**

- Cancellation requests can be made with a minimum of 24 hours notice.
- Excursion days may incur a full fee charge if the care session can't be filled by children on the waiting list.
- Absences without notifying the service will also incur a full fee.

# **Clothing**

- Children must wear sun smart clothing, and **bring a bucket hat** when in attendance during Terms 1, 3 and 4.
- Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times during care.

# **Behaviour Support**

- Our service adopts a 4 stage Behaviour Support System to provide children opportunities to reflect and learn from inappropriate and unsafe choices.
- Exclusion from care will be implemented as a last resort in response to behaviours of concern such as violence, harassment and illegal acts that threaten the safety and well-being of members of the OSHC community.

#### **Food**

### Medication
